RESOLUTION 2012 – 61

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO TERMINATE ANY RELATIONSHIP WITH WORK TRAIN STAFFING, LLC FOR THE PROVISION OF TEMPORARY STAFFING; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO TERMINATE ANY RELATIONSHIP WITH WORK TRAIN STAFFING, LLC. AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, representatives of Clayton County, Georgia and Work Train Staffing, LLC (“Work Train”) executed a document entitled “Agreement for Services” which provided for the terms and conditions under which employment staffing services would be provided; and

WHEREAS, Work Train has determined that it is unable to provide the services for the cost originally represented in its Agreement with Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, both Work Train and the Board of Commissioners have determined that it is in the best interest of the Parties to terminate their relationship and any agreement that might exist between them effective Friday, March 16, 2012, at 5 o’clock p.m. for the reasons contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED.

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County to terminate its relationship with Work Train Staffing, LLC. The Board also authorizes the

Chairman to execute any documents necessary to terminate the relationship and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The termination document shall be in substantially the form attached hereto.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

SO RESOLVED, this the 20th day of March, 2012.


