RESOLUTION NO. 2014-66

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE, FINANCIAL CRIMES TASK FORCE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500.00; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department was awarded a Grant by the United States Secret Service, Financial Crimes Task Force, to purchase equipment and training in the amount of \$500.00, with no matching County funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will be best served by participating in this grant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute a grant agreement with the United States Secret Service, Financial Crimes Task Force, for the purchase of training and equipment to be purchased with no matching County funds and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


