Clayton County Citizens, Community Leaders and Employees Participate in Chairman Turner's 2014 Clean-Up Initiative

Jonesboro, Georgia (October 21, 2014) — On Friday, October 17, 2014, Clayton County citizens, community leaders and employees participated in the first Clean-up Initiative hosted by Chairman Jeffrey E. Turner. Participants met at the Clayton County Justice Center for opening remarks, received a briefing on safety equipment, transportation, and assignment locations. The Corrections Department provided vehicles that transported the teams of 5 to 15 people to their designated locations. The clean-up route was divided into five (5) sections focusing on the median of Tara Boulevard.

Sections included:

- Justice Complex south to South Main Street
- Justice Complex north to North Avenue
- South Main Street south to Home Depot
- North Avenue north to Battle Creek Road
- Battle Creek Road north to Upper Riverdale Road
