STANDING ORDER OF CLAYTON COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT
UNDER O.C.G.A § 19-1-1

This order applies to all domestic relations actions as that term is defined in O.C.G.A § 19-1-1(a), and upon notice, binds the parties, their agents, servants, employees, and all other persons acting in concert with the parties to this action.

Each of the parties is enjoined and restrained from unilaterally causing or permitting the minor child or children of the parties to be removed from the jurisdiction of the court without the permission of the court except in an emergency which has been created by the other party to the action.

Each of the parties is enjoined and restrained from doing, attempting to do, or threatening to do any act which injures, maltreats, vilifies, molests, harasses, or which may, upon judicial determination, constitute threats, harassment, stalking, or any act which constitutes a violation of other civil or criminal laws of this state to the adverse party, child, or children of the parties. Neither party shall use any code or password to access the Electronic Mail (E-Mail) addressed to or from the other party.

Each of the parties (including any legal entities controlled by the parties) is enjoined and restrained from selling, encumbering, trading, contracting to sell, otherwise disposing of, or removing from the jurisdiction of the court, without the permission of the court, any of the property belonging to the parties except in the ordinary course of business except in an emergency which has been created by the other party to the action.

If minor children are involved, the parties are required to attend a seminar for divorcing parents. Attendance may be scheduled by calling (770) 477-4575.

Upon written motion of a party, the standing order provided for in this code section shall be reviewed by the Court at any rule nisi hearing.

This order supersedes the standing orders dated May 17, 2006; February 19, 2003; May 22, 1995 and March 3, 1999.
