- 2. The Agenda was adopted.
- 3. Calendar Call.
 - a. Kimberle Windley (Sheriff's Office) Termination Appeal
 - i. Appellant Attorney Keith Martin was present and ready to proceed.
 - ii. County Attorney Michelle Youngblood was present and ready to proceed.
 - iii. Chairman Bartlett confirmed the *Windley* matter was first on the agenda.

b. Andrea Cooper, Clerk State Court - Termination appeal

- i. County Attorney Youngblood was present and ready to proceed and advised the Board that one of the County's witnesses was not available until tomorrow.

c. R.C. Montgomery, District Attorney's Office - Five (5) day suspension appeal
