A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND PUBLICATION OF QUALIFYING FEES FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF CLAYTON COUNTY SHERIFF; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Election and Registration Office is requesting approval of the 2023 Special Election Qualifying Fees for the special election to fill the unexpired term of the Clayton County Sheriff to be held on March 21, 2023.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of O.C.G.A. §21-2-131, it is the duty of the governing authority to fix and publish a qualifying fee for each County office to be filled in the upcoming special election at least 35 days prior to the special election; and

WHEREAS, qualifying will be held January 23 through January 27, 2023, and the qualifying fees need to be set prior to qualifying pursuant to O.C.G.A 21-2-131(a)(1)(A); and

WHEREAS, the qualifying fee to run for all other elected county offices, specifically the Sheriff, is three percent (3%) of the total gross salary of the office paid in the previous year, including all supplements authorized by law; or if the elected official is not paid a salary, the commissioners must set a fee that is not more than three percent (3%) of the income that the elected official earned from the office in the previous year; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 21-2-131, the Board of Commissioners hereby sets and publishes the qualifying fees for the special election of the Sheriff at \$4,317.99.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
