RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 36

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING LEGISLATION TO CREATE A STATUTORY ETHICS POLICY FOR THE CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2008, the Clayton County Board of Education passed a Resolution to Request the State Legislature to Strengthen its Ethics Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education previously adopted an Ethics Policy which governs its members' conduct; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education recently recognized the need to strengthen its Ethics Policy and to clearly set forth the type of conduct prohibited under the Ethics Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by the Clayton County State Legislature introducing legislation creating a statutory Ethics Policy for the Clayton County Board of Education.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS


