RESOLUTION NO. 2009 – 44

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH STATE OF GEORGIA, DIVISION OF FAMILY AND CHILDREN SERVICES ON BEHALF OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY EXTENSION SERVICE PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH PARENT AIDE SERVICES WILL BE DELIVERED, AND ADMINISTERED, AND TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF GEORGIA TO FUND THE PARENT AIDE PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY, AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (the "County") desires to make parent aide services available to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the State of Georgia, Division of Family and Children Services ("DFACS") will provide funding and oversight of the parent aide services program; and

WHEREAS, reimbursement to the County from DFACS will be calculated on fee per service based on the fee schedule, with no match required from the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by entering into the memorandum of understanding for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County to enter into a memorandum of understanding, on behalf of the Clayton County Extension Service, with the State of Georgia, Division of Family and Children Services to accept grant funds associated with the Parent Aide Services Program. The agreement is attached hereto.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the memorandum of understanding on behalf of the County and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






