RESOLUTION NO. 2009 – 109

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF FOREST PARK FOR THE ALLOCATION OF STATE FUNDS FOR MAINTENANCE AND UPKEEP OF FOREST PARK ROADS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT THE APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENSES RELATING THERETO; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, each year the City of Forest Park selects and identifies roads in need of resurfacing; and

WHEREAS, Forest Park contracts with and receives funds from the State of Georgia Department of Transportation ("GDOT") through the Local Assistance Repaving Program ("LARP") for the repair and maintenance of certain paved roads located in the City of Forest Park; and

WHEREAS, GDOT approves certain roadways for repaving and/or repair; and
WHEREAS, Clayton County has the resources to resurface the roads located in the City
of Forest Park selected for the LARP; and

WHEREAS, in the past, the parties have operated without a formal Agreement in place and have concluded that an Agreement is in the best interests of both parties; and WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and that the County will best be served by entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED.

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Forest Park for the allocation of state funds for the maintenance and upkeep of Forest Park roads. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect the appropriations and expenses relating thereto. The Agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
