RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 150

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A VEHICLE FROM THE UNITED STATES MARSHAL SERVICE TO BE USED BY THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR USE WITH THE DISTRICT/REGIONAL FUGITIVE TASK FORCE ; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT AND BILL OF SALE, TOGETHER WITH ANY OTHER DOCUMENT NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO ADD THE VEHICLE TO THE COUNTY'S INVENTORY FLEET; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, United States Marshal Service wishes to donate to the County a vehicle to be purchased, for use by the Sheriff's Office as part of the participation with the District/Regional Fugitive Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by accepting the vehicle from the United States Marshals Service for the above-stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept a vehicle from the United States Marshal Service to be used by the Sheriff's Office in connection with its participation in the District/Regional Fugitive Task Force. The Board of

Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman or his designee to execute an Agreement and Bill of Sale, together with any other document necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Director of Central Services to add the vehicle to the County's inventory fleet.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

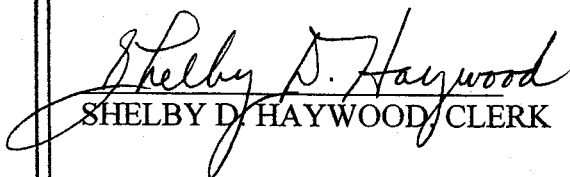
