RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 64

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF VEHICLES TO BE ASSIGNED TO THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT FLEET IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Sheriff's Department is requesting acceptance and assignment of a 2001 Ford Sport Trac, VIN # 1FMZU77E21UA77366; 2005 Chevrolet Silverado, VIN 1GCHK23295F841079; and 2003 GMC Sierra, VIN # 2GTEC19V431249153 into the Department's fleet; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Fleet Maintenance has determined said vehicles are suitable for service as County vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by accepting said vehicles and assigning them to the Clayton County Sheriff's Department fleet to enhance law enforcement in accordance with applicable State and Federal Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, to accept and assign a 2001 Ford Sport Trac, VIN # 1FMZU77E21UA77366; 2005 Chevrolet Silverado, VIN 1GCHK23295F841079; and 2003 GMC Sierra, VIN # 2GTEC19V431249153 to the Clayton County Sheriff's Department vehicle fleet for the purpose of enhancing law enforcement. The Directors of Central Services and Fleet Maintenance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution. Further, the Director of Finance is authorized to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


