RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 151

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ALLOW THE CLAYTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO HOST A SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT AT THE LOVEJOY SOFTBALL COMPLEX TO RAISE FUNDS FOR THE FAMILY OF DEPUTY RICHARD DALY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, in memory of Deputy Richard Daly, the Clayton County Sheriff's Office desires to organize and host a softball tournament on September 24, 2011 at the Lovejoy Softball Complex to financially assist the family of Deputy Daly; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office shall have sole responsibility for organizing, providing security for, promoting and managing the tournament, with no capital expense to Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, all proceeds raised will be donated to the Daly family; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing the Sheriff's Office to utilize the Lovejoy Softball Complex for this purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to allow the Clayton County Sheriff's Office to host a softball tournament on September 24, 2011 at the Lovejoy Softball Complex to financially assist the family of Deputy Richard Daly.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to perform any acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.




