RESOLUTION 2011 – 155

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR A CHANGE IN THE NAME OF THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY OF AVIATION BOULEVARD TO “MAYNARD H. JACKSON JR. BOULEVARD”; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY REQUIRED DOCUMENT AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by renaming the remaining public road right-of-way of Aviation Boulevard located within unincorporated Clayton County to “Maynard H. Jackson Jr. Boulevard” which will serve as a main entrance road to the new Maynard Holbrook Jackson Jr. International Terminal at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to rename the remaining public road right-of-way of Aviation Boulevard located within unincorporated Clayton County to “Maynard H. Jackson Jr. Boulevard”. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute any required document and otherwise to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board of Commissioners is hereby requested to notify all those property owners located on the affected right-of-way of the change in name, and

to ask that all interested County Departments take appropriate action to amend the maps, signs, and records of Clayton County to reflect this name change.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective sixty (60) days from the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
