A RESOLUTION LIFTING A HIRING FREEZE ON ALL CLAYTON COUNTY EMPLOYEE POSITIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2011, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution 2011 – 27, thereby establishing a hiring freeze to be in effect until further notice and disallowing the filling of any position, exempt or non-exempt, which was then vacant, or which would become vacant, except with the approval of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board to lift the hiring freeze at this time.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby lifts the hiring freeze previously established in Resolution 2011 – 27.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


