Any decisions regarding the hiring or termination of any Constituent Aide will require the consent of the District Commissioner to whom the Constituent Aide reports.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners. All conflicting Resolutions or parts of Resolutions are hereby repealed.
