RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 208

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A SOUND SYSTEM THAT WAS DONATED TO THE CLAYTON REGIONAL POLICE ACADEMY; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO DISPOSE OF THE SOUND SYSTEM IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Police Department has located sound equipment including a mixing board, two speakers and cables that was donated to the Clayton Regional Police Academy; and

WHEREAS, this sound equipment has been in storage since the Clayton Regional Police Academy was closed; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has determined that the equipment is of no use to the Police Academy and needs to be disposed of as surplus equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of the sound equipment as directed in this resolution,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, to accept sound equipment that includes a mixing board, two speakers and cables, that was placed in storage after the closing of the Clayton Regional Police Academy. The Police Department has possession of the equipment and determined that it is surplus property of no use to the Police Department. The Director of Central Services is authorized to place the equipment in service with any other department that can make use of it; or to donate the equipment to the Clayton County Board of Education; or if they reject it, to dispose of the equipment as provided by law as surplus county equipment. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




