RESOLUTION NO. 2014-63

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ALLOW THE KIWANIS CLUB OF LOVEJOY TO SPONSOR AND HOST A 5K SCHOLARSHIP ROAD RACE AT THE GERALD MATTHEWS COMPLEX; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County has traditionally supported the work of various non-profit organizations, governmental agencies, and professional service providers located and conducting business in Clayton County for the benefit of the County's citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Kiwanis Club of Lovejoy (the "Promoter") desires to sponsor and host a 5K Scholarship Road Race on April 12, 2014 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Gerald Matthews Complex parking lot, the race route including two laps around the perimeter of the park; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter will use this event to raise funds for its college scholarship program, which benefits a graduating senior from Lovejoy High School; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter shall have sole responsibility for organizing, promoting and managing the event, with no capital expense to Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing the Promoter to host this event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to allow the Kiwanis Club of Lovejoy to sponsor and host on April 12, 2014 a 5K Scholarship Road Race at the Gerald Matthews Complex.


Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to perform any acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners and is contingent upon complete satisfaction of all insurance requirements prior to the initial event date as provided by the Clayton County Risk Management Department.
