## RESOLUTION NO. 2014-173

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT FOUR TELEVISIONS AS ABANDONED PROPERTY PURSUANT TO OCGA § 17-5-54(A)(1) AND SUPERIOR COURT ORDER 14CV01569-5 FOR OFFICIAL USE BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT THE PROPERTY ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY, TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department came into the possession of four televisions as property which was unclaimed in excess of ninety days, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to OCGA § 17-5-54(a)(1), the Police Department did petition the Superior Court of Clayton County for an order to allow the Department to retain the televisions for official use; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court did grant the petition and issued an Order, under Superior Court Case Number 14CV01569-5, that the Department may retain the televisions for official use; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by accepting the televisions for the stated purpose.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to Section 1. accept four television sets pursuant to an Order issued in Superior Court Case Number 14CV01569-5 and in accordance with OCGA § 17-5-54(a)(1). The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman, or his designee, to execute any documents necessary, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
