## RESOLUTION NO. 2015 – 249

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF FUNDS TO THE CITY OF LOVEJOY TO ASSIST WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MULTI-PURPOSE RECREATIONAL FIELD; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ANY ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET AS NEEDED TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Solid Waste Management Authority recently voted to convey approximately 3.72 acres of land to the City of Lovejoy for the development of a multi-purpose recreational field; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners wishes to provide funding in the amount of \$50,000.00 to assist with this development; and

WHEREAS, funding is available through the 2009 SPLOST Program which included park upgrades at existing parks as a County SPLOST project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by providing the funds for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes conveyance of \$50,000.00 from 2009 SPLOST Program funds to the City of Lovejoy for the purpose of assisting with the development of a multi-purpose recreational field. The Board authorizes the Chairman to perform any acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution and

authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget as needed to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
