RESOLUTION NO. 2015 – 253

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA EXTENSION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM EDUCATION, FOR THE CONVERSION OF A PART-TIME EMPLOYEE TO A FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE AND FOR THE ADDITION OF TWO FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Education (“SNAP-Ed”) is designed to improve the likelihood that persons eligible for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program will make healthy dietary choices within their limited budgets; and

WHEREAS, the persons eligible for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program would benefit from increased educational resources in Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County Extension Service currently only employs one (1) part-time staff member to implement SNAP-Ed; and

WHEREAS, UGA Extension wishes to provide funding to convert the current part-time position to a full-time SNAP agent position, including benefits; and

WHEREAS, UGA Extension wishes to fund two (2) full-time SNAP program assistant positions, including benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by entering into an Agreement with UGA Extension for the reasons stated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

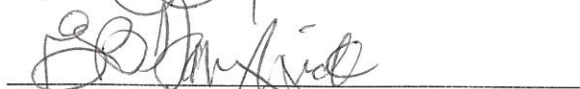
Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an Agreement with UGA Extension providing for implementation of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Education. The Board hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

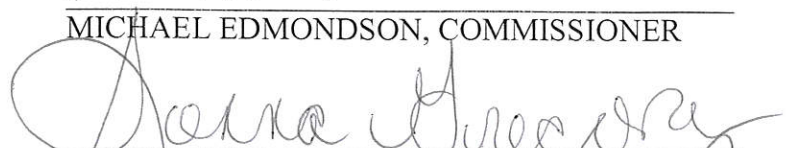

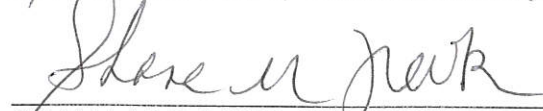
