RESOLUTION NO. 2015-102

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FORENSIC PHOTOGRAPHY, INC., PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH PHOTOGRAPHY AND RELATED SERVICES WILL BE PROVIDED; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County is in need of professional general and forensic photographic services for the Clayton County Board of Commissioners, District Attorney, Solicitor General, Sheriff, Police, Fire and Emergency Management Services Departments (the "Users") and all County departments within the jurisdiction and direction of the Users requiring such services to fulfill the statutory duties and responsibilities required in their respective offices; and

WHEREAS, Forensic Photography, Inc., is eminently qualified and has agreed to provide such photographic and related services under the terms and conditions as set forth in Attachment "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will be best served by entering into an Agreement with Forensic Photography, Inc., for photography services as stated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the County to enter into an Agreement with Forensic Photography, Inc., providing for the terms and conditions under which photographic and related services will be rendered to the County as set forth in Attachment "A". The Board

hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
