A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE GEORGIA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR THE CONTINUED PURPOSE OF REDUCING RECIDIVIST MATTERS WITHIN THE CLAYTON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS DEEMED NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET AS NEEDED TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Juvenile Court wishes to apply for and, if awarded accept up to \$750,000.00 in grant funds from the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council for the 2016 Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention and Treatment Program with no local match required; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by authorizing Juvenile Court to apply for and, if awarded, accept Juvenile Justice Incentive Grant funding for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County on behalf of Clayton County Juvenile Court to apply for and, if awarded, accept Juvenile Justice Incentive Grant funding in an amount up to \$750,000.00. The Board of Commissioners

hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Grant Application as well as any related documents, and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
