RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 34

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA TO ALLOW MR. JOSHUA BENTON OF TROOP 3499 OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA TO PROVIDE BEAUTIFICATION, SIGNAGE, FENCING AND SEATING WITH STORAGE STRUCTURES TO THE COMMUNITY GARDEN LOCATED AT THE CARL RHODENIZER RECREATION CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Joshua Benton is a member of Troop 3499 of the Boy Scouts of America at the Carl Rhodenizer Recreation Center (the “Center”); and

WHEREAS, the Center contains a Community Garden that allows members of the community to plant and grow fruits, vegetables, flowers and plants; and

WHEREAS, Joshua Benton, as part of his Eagle Scout requirements would like to undertake a project to beautify the Gardens, by organizing the various plants, fruits and vegetables, adding a walkway, benches and a fence.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing Joshua Benton to complete his service on the Community Gardens of Carl Rhodenizer Recreation Center.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS


