RESOLUTION NO. 2021-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT A LASER ALLY LIDAR SYSTEM DONATION FROM DIGITAL-ALLY FOR THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO ACCEPT THE DONATION ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Digital-Ally wishes to donate a Laser Ally LIDAR system for speed detection to the Clayton County Police Department (the "Department"); and

WHEREAS, the Department will use the Laser Ally Lidar system to help the County enforce posted speed limits; and

WHEREAS, the donation, valued at \$995, is an unconditional gift to Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the Clayton County and the County will best be served by the acceptance of the donation for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County Police Department to accept a Laser Ally LIDAR system donation from Digital-Ally. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to accept the donation on behalf of Clayton County and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




