New Business

W.B. Casey Secondary Launder Covers RFB Recommendation: Water Reclamation Director Kendra Stanciel presented a bid recommendation for secondary launder covers at the W.B. Casey Biosolids Facility.

The W.B. Casey Water Resource and Recovery Facility is our largest Water Reclamation Plant with a permitted capacity of 24 Million Gallons per Day (MGD). The facility's secondary clarifiers are responsible for removing smaller particles that are unable to be removed by the primary clarifiers. The slowing of flow, increase in time and the exposure to sunlight creates issues with algae. As part of our most recent addition to our permit (Flint River Discharge of up to 6 MGD) and using UV Disinfectant it is critical that we prevent as much algal growth as possible from moving through the process. The dislodging of algae will cover the UV bulbs which would prevent disinfection of the effluent which in turn would lead to a permit violation. The addition of the launder covers will inhibit algae growth, reduce manpower, and contain odors within the clarifier.

A Request for Bid for Secondary Launder Covers was advertised March 2, 2022, through March 23, 2022. A non-mandatory site visit was held on March 23, 2022, at 2:00 pm and bids were opened on April 5, 2022, via Virtual Teams Meeting. A total of two bids was received. The bidders and their bid amount are in the table below:

RESOLVED to award the bid to Cornerstone H2O in the amount of \$126,350.00 for the WRRF Secondary Launder Covers contingent upon the bidder meeting risk management requirements, providing acceptable bonds and executing the contract as well as the Board authorizing the General Manager to sign the contract.

Annual Chemical Bid Sodium Bisulfite Award Rescind & New Quote Award Recommendation:

Water Production Director Coty McDaniel presented a bid recommendation for Sodium Bisulfite award rescind and new quote award.

On March 31st, CCWA Board of Directors approved Annual Chemical Bid recommendations. Specialty Chemical Company was awarded the bid as the lowest responsive responsible bidder for Sodium Bisulfate at \$0.3279/LB (55-gallon drums). The request for bids was for Sodium "Bisulfate" rather than Sodium "Bisulfite". In addition, during the construction of the dechlorination system at the Hooper Plant, it was decided that Sodium Bisulfite be stored and dosed through a (200-300 gallon) tote system and not the 55-gallon drum system which was in the original request for bid. As a result, CCWA sent out a new request for quotes for (200-300 gallon) Sodium Bisulfite totes. The request for quotes were sent out on April 14, 2022. Four (4) quotes were received.

This award is for the period of May 6, 2022 through April 30, 2023, at the unit price as quoted.
